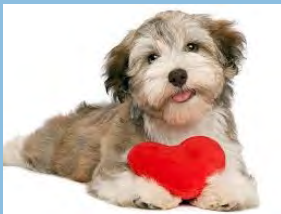

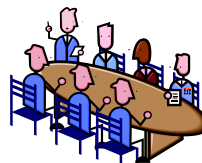

Executive Committee Meeting Minutes – January 6, 2015...

Present: Ellen Wester, Bahre Willis, Pam Bacon, Bill Brown, Diani Johnson, Robert Carter

Meeting was called to order by Ellen at 6:20 PM.

Secretary's Report: A motion to accept the Secretary's Report of Dec 4th and 6th was made, seconded and approved by the Committee members in attendance.

Treasurer's Report: Bill gave the Treasurer's report of a balance of \$2,759.00 at the end of Dec 2014 (does not include \$200.00 in cash box). A motion was made and seconded and approved by the Committee members in attendance. Bill turned over the Treasurer's books and check book to Diani at this time.

Old Business: Discussion of the dance on December 6th addressed the issue of not having a bar and as to why this happened. We all agreed that it was a nice Christmas dance including the food, venue and fellowship. Bahre will be checking into our options with the ABC Board and report to our committee as to what we can do to have alcohol at our upcoming dances at the Brunswick County Southport Senior Center. We hope to have this resolved by our next dance there which will be Feb 27th. The January 9th dance will be at the VFW and will be potluck for food. Rob and Diani will be door greeters and take up the money. There will be no theme for this dance.

New Business: Our Re-Up / Join-Up dance will be Jan 23rd at the Moose Lodge. Ellen will meet with Moose Lodge management and discuss the food. She will see about having BBQ, slaw, baked beans and rolls for the price of \$6.00 or \$7.00 per person. The club will pay for this dinner. We are going to have 4 people at the door to collect the membership applications and take the money and then have another station with 2 people to hand out the membership cards. The cost to join will remain \$20.00 to include admission into the dance and a meal.

The February 13th dance will be at the VFW. This will be our Valentine dance. The DJ will be Terry McPhail. Ellen will talk to Brad about preparing a roast beef plate with 2 sides for \$6.00 or \$7.00 a person. Pam will get two dozen roses to be given to two lucky ladies. Each woman will get a ticket upon arrival and this will be drawn during the time of the 50/50.

Open Discussion: Dates and times were set 2015's board meetings. Meetings will be on the first Wednesday of each month and held at different sites. They will start at 6 PM and be listed of their location in the minutes. Meetings are open to all members to attend. Ellen would like to work on forming committees for Setup/Decorations and Clean-Up. If each member would help with the cleanup it would only be one dance a year. The janitor at the Brunswick Center has agreed to set up and take down tables after our dances. At our Christmas party we gave him \$40.00 for this and he said he would continue to do this for us.

Name Tags were discussed. A motion was made that the club buy the first name tag for each club member and if they are lost then the club member would be responsible for the next one. We will order them after the Re-Up/Join-Up dance for the first round and as the memberships come in we will make additional orders. The badges will be the type that has magnets on the back.

The new board would like to look into some clarification of the bylaws in the future. This will be looked at over the year.

Meeting adjourned at 8:50 PM.

Duck's Beach Club (North Myrtle Beach)...

AN OPEN MESSAGE TO ALL SHAGGERS FROM THE OWNER OF DUCK'S...

At Duck's, we face a huge decision to make as to which way to go during future SOS's. When SOS was founded years ago, the venue was Shag Music, DJ's and heavy partying, and I mean heavy partying. Times are changing, the weeks, months and years are flying by and many of us are aging out and just can't hang in there as we use to when we were younger. I am proud to say that I belonged to the Charlotte Shag Club and was the President of the Boppers Shag Club when I lived in Charlotte and bought Duck's in December 2004. It's hard to believe it's been over 10 years now... time does fly!!

There is a very strong move away from DJ's to bands during each of the past 10 SOS's. Yes, Duck's has gone to bands during the year to keep our doors open here in NMB, due to two very strong and excellent Shag Clubs located in NMB, the Ocean Drive Shag Club located at Fat Harold's and OD Pavilion Social Shag Club, located at the OD Pavilion. Both business's have the large majority of local shaggers going to these clubs supporting them and for the most part have used DJ's. This left Duck's with the necessity of going to a different venue to draw customers who loved bands and would party with us and keep revenue's coming in so we could stay in business. It was an extremely difficult decision for me to make, moving away from DJ's 100% of the time to using bands but, it was strictly a business decision to keep Duck's open or close the doors for good and stop losing thousands of dollars every month.

However, we made a promise to all shaggers to stay with DJ's during SOS, except for the 1st Sunday and the last Sunday of SPRING & FALL SOS. Other than those two Sunday's, we have kept our promise to stay with DJ's and during this up coming Spring & Fall SOS's we will have an average of 34 DJ's playing, twice as many as any of the other clubs. All in an effort to please and entertain our customers with what we believe is some of the "best of the best" DJ's who are from many different states, representing many different SOS Shag Clubs. There are many other excellent DJ's that play at the other member SOS Beach Club's here in NMB and, they are loyal to those clubs and will not DJ elsewhere, and the same is true with many of Duck's DJ's. However, the majority all belong to the Association of Beach & Shag Club DJ's which, supports SOS 1,000% as a SUBSCRIBER MEMBER and has for many, many years.

As stated previously, there is a strong move of shaggers going to other club's in NMB who have bands every day such as the Avista Resort, Spanish Galleon, OD Beach Club, and more bands at Fat Harold's, which is now owned by Harold Worley (owner of the Ocean Drive Hotel/Spanish Galleon, etc.). The bands pull shaggers away from the member SOS Beach Clubs in NMB such as OD Arcade, Pirates Cove and Duck's & Duck's Cafe who have continued to use mainly DJ's and have always depended on each SOS for a large portion of the yearly revenues.

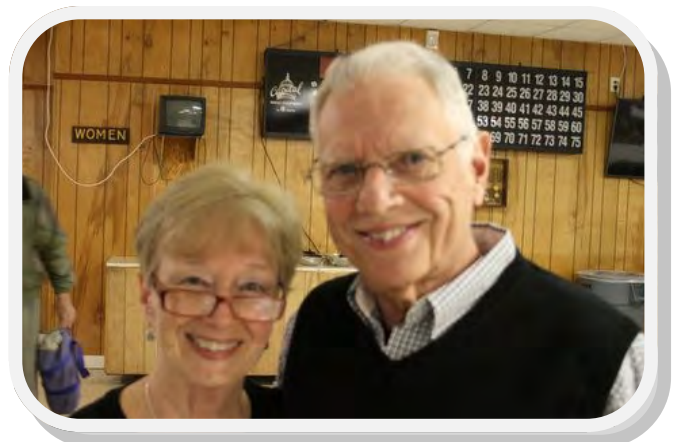
Our dilemma is simple, at Duck's are #1 goal is to please you, our customers, in every way we can and we value your opinion, your ideas, your suggestions and respectfully request that you let us know how you feel. Should we reduce having DJ's and start booking bands in order to stay busy or, do you want us to stay with what SOS has always been in the past... LIVE IN PERSON DJ'S PLAYING SHAG MUSIC!
